### Eligibility

Any WAFCS/AAFCS professional member who has earned a family and consumer sciences degree, who has been a member of WAFCS for at least two consecutive years prior to the nomination, and who has completed three (3) to eight (8) years of service to the field is eligible to receive this award. WAFCS members can only receive the New Achiever Award once.

The recipient must receive an average score of 80 points or more of the 100 points allowed.

### Nomination Process

Nominations must be made by a sanctioned entity of the Association (such as an affiliate, community, committee, or unit, etc.). **The nominee is permitted to participate in preparing the nomination materials.**

To nominate an WAFCS member for the 2018 New Achiever Award, complete two steps by the August 30.:

Step 1 – Read the WAFCS New Achiever Award Guidelines.

Step 2 – Complete the following and submit them in PDF form and jpg, Karen Bergh ([berghkm@mail.com](mailto:berghkm@mail.com) or 434 100<sup>th</sup> Ave SE, Olympia, WA 986501) by August 30.

- A. Submit a signed letter of nomination from the affiliate president or leader of the nominating group that describes what makes the nominee outstanding.
- B. Curriculum vitae/resume: Three (3) page maximum, single-spaced, may use bullet form, with one-inch margins and 12-point regular sans-serif font (Arial, Tahoma, and Helvetica are some examples of sans-serif fonts), and in PDF format that has been updated within the past year.
- C. Maximum of four (4) pages of supporting materials (may include brochures; programs; photographs; newsletters; newspaper, magazine, and journal articles; complete bibliographical citations; and other relevant supporting material that address each of the evaluation criteria listed in the guidelines).
- D. **Photo of candidate:** A photograph of the candidate is requested and submission of a photograph provides AAFCS with permission to use the photography for publicity purposes. Provide photo in JPG format.

- **Submit the attachments described in A-C in PDF format, and D as a JPG image.**
- **Please submit materials in the order requested. Please use headings to identify content. All materials must be submitted must be in English.**
- **Please keep a copy of all materials submitted to AAFCS; materials will not be returned to the nominee.**
